**Tulalip Drug Task Force Executes Residential Warrant**

**Tulalip, WA – January 14, 2025** – The Tulalip Drug Task Force received tips regarding suspected drug activity in Tribal Housing. During the investigation, Detectives identified a suspect living at the residence who was actively selling narcotics such as powder fentanyl, fentanyl pills, and crack cocaine.

On January 14, 2025, the Tulalip Police Department executed a search warrant at the residence. The primary suspect was arrested along with other occupants for narcotics violations and outstanding arrest warrants. During the search of the residence, Detectives seized fentanyl powder, fentanyl pills, crack cocaine, and drug-weighing/packaging material. Additionally, two illegally possessed firearms were seized.

The primary suspect was booked into the Snohomish County Jail for the drugs and firearms violations.
