Incident Report: Stolen Vehicle Pursuit

On December 5, 2024, at approximately 9:30 PM, the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office initiated a pursuit of a stolen vehicle that entered the Tulalip reservation. Tulalip Police Department (TPD) officers did not participate in the pursuit. Due to increasing danger, deputies terminated the pursuit. Shortly after, the vehicle was found crashed near the 7600 block of Totem Beach Road, with two suspects seen fleeing the scene. Despite a thorough search, the suspects were not located.
