Tulalip Tribal Drug Task Force Narcotics Investigation



Tulalip, WA – Over the past few months, Detectives with the Tulalip Tribal Drug Task Force (TTDTF) learned of a suspected narcotics dealer who frequently drove the Tulalip Reservation and sold narcotics to Tulalip Tribal members who live in Tulalip Tribal Housing areas. After months of investigation and surveillance, TTDTF Detectives arrested the suspect this week as they were delivering narcotics to the Tulalip Reservation.

Following the suspect's arrest, TTDTF Detectives executed a search warrant with the Everett Police Anti-Crime Team on the suspect's residence. During the search of the suspect's residence and vehicle, Detectives seized 10,722 Fentanyl Pills, 433 grams of methamphetamine, 2.12 pounds of fentanyl, four illegally possessed firearms, and currency as suspected proceeds from illegal narcotics sales.

The suspect was booked into the Snohomish County Jail and the investigation is ongoing.
