**Major Drug Arrest – Tulalip Reservation**

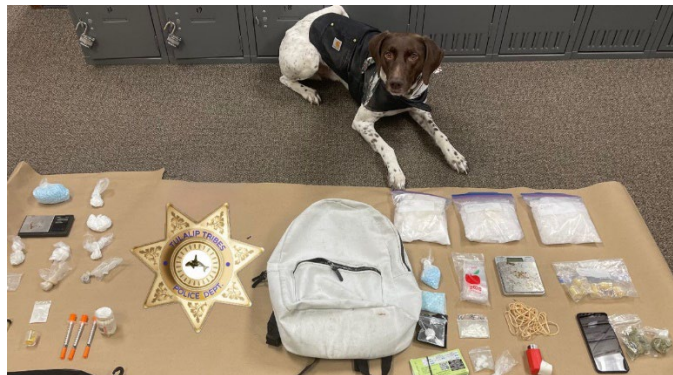
**Tulalip, WA – February 11, 2025** – On November 29, 2024, Tulalip K9 Officer Jira initiated a traffic stop within the boundaries of the Tulalip Reservation. During the investigation, Officer Jira’s partner, K9 Buster, was deployed and alerted to the vehicle. The vehicle was impounded for a search warrant, and the following items were seized:

- Approximately 3 pounds of suspected methamphetamine
- 19 grams of heroin
- 1,437 “M30” pills
- 2.3 ounces of fentanyl powder

On February 6, the suspect was located off the Reservation by the Snohomish County Regional Drug Task Force. During the arrest and search of the suspect's home, the following evidence was located:

- 247 grams of suspected methamphetamine
- 128 grams of cocaine
- 19 grams of fentanyl
- Approximately 3,500 “M30” pills
- Over \$1,200 in currency

The Tulalip Police Department works hard every day to hold drug offenders accountable.
